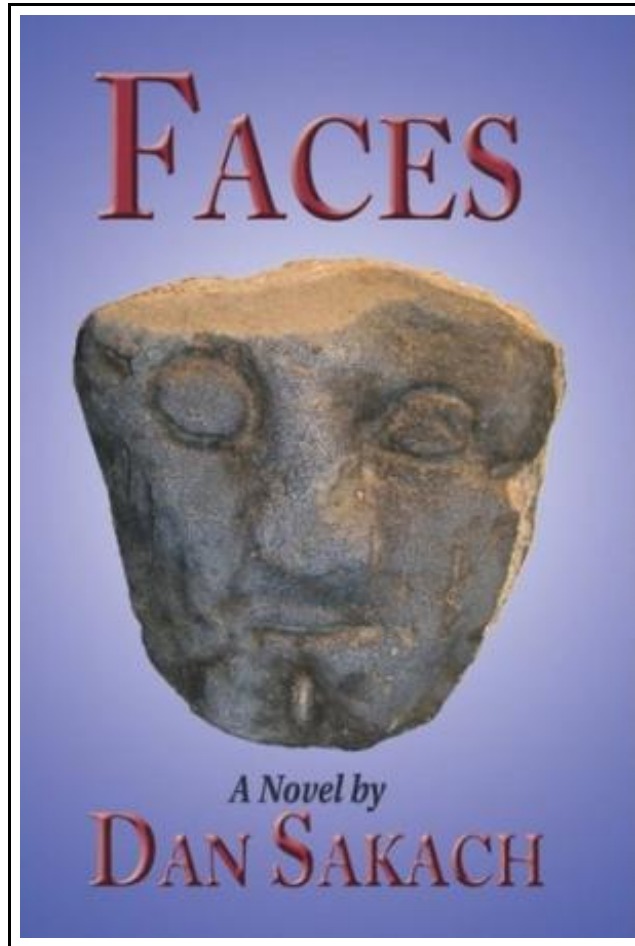

Tears and laughter flow in this timeless drama of the human heart.
